Subject: Presence of EU REACH SVHC in Honeywell Products

In June 2007, the European Union Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) entered into force. This Regulation establishes specific duties and obligations on companies engaged in commerce with the European Union (EU) member states that manufacture or import substances on their own, in preparations, or in articles.

In regards to the EU REACH Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern for Authorisation (SVHC Candidate List), as amended, Honeywell confirms that we comply with the user notification requirements of EU REACH, Article 33. This communication refers to the SVHC Candidate List published on 07 JUL 2017 (“REACH 174”). As part of this SVHC identification process we have:

- Reviewed internal/publicly available engineering data in relation to the presence of SVHCs in our products or any of their component parts;
- Reviewed available safety data sheets for our input materials;
- Communicated with our suppliers to exclude/confirm the presence of SVHCs in component parts of our products.

As a result of this ongoing process, we confirm that, to the best of our knowledge, the products we currently supply, and for which we do not provide a notification to the user, do not contain any SVHCs included in the SVHC Candidate List in concentrations above 0.1 % (w/w).
